Procedure to Update the Faculty Handbook

After all faculty meetings and workshops are finished for the school year, the chair of each standing faculty policy committee will carefully review the Faculty Handbook and submit changes or revisions that have been approved that year to the Senior Vice Provost by June 1. The Provost and Senior Vice Provost will review these changes and incorporate these, and other changes approved by the President's Cabinet into the Faculty Handbook. Some additional, non-policy changes, clarifying processes or language, may be made by the Provost and Senior Vice Provost in the course of editing the handbook.
